



Elementary International Student Report Cards – Instructions

The Ministry of Education has developed educational framework agreements with a number of countries. These agreements allow students to study in BC schools for a period of time and return to their home country having received credit for their time with us.

Teachers and schools should follow the usual assessment and conference-based reporting procedures in place for resident students, including the end of year MYEDBC summative report. Conferencing is done with the agent, custodian, or parent. **In addition, an International Student Report Card is required at the end of the school year and/or when the student exits the program.**

A template will be sent to the schools to be distributed to the international students' teachers. Teachers must fill out the grades and add any necessary comments, then sign the bottom of the report. The students' legal names must be used on the reports.
